



Brow Lamination Treatment Pre-Care Instructions:

Brow Lamination is a semi-permanent treatment that lifts and sets the brow hairs in a desired shape, giving a fuller, more defined look. To ensure the best results and minimize irritation, please follow these guidelines before your appointment:

48-72 Hours Prior to Treatment:

- Avoid applying retinoids (Retin-A, Tretinoin), AHAs, BHAs, or exfoliating products around the brow area.
- Do not wax, thread, tweeze, or tint your eyebrows. Your brow artist will shape them appropriately during or after lamination.
- Refrain from tanning or sunbathing to prevent skin sensitivity.
- Avoid using facial peels or harsh exfoliants around the brow area.

24 Hours Prior to Treatment:

- Do not apply heavy creams, oils, or serums on or around the eyebrows.
- Avoid self-tanners on the face.
- Refrain from any brow makeup application.

Day of Treatment:

- Arrive with a clean, makeup-free face—no foundation, powders, brow products, or skincare on the brow area.
- Inform your provider if you have had any recent skin treatments (chemical peels, microdermabrasion, microneedling, laser) within the last 7 days.

Important Considerations:

- Let your technician know if you have:
 - Very sensitive skin or a history of allergic reactions.
 - Brow tattoos/microblading.
 - Skin conditions such as eczema, psoriasis, or dermatitis around the brow area.
- Brow Lamination is not recommended if you are pregnant or breastfeeding without physician approval.
